**7.      Adoption of budget**

Moved by Louis Lair that the total expenses for the 2017 budget be in the amount of \$ 3,075,248 and that the mill rate remain at 0.65¢/\$100 of evaluation and that all service taxes remain unchanged as follows: the basic service tax for water at \$420, the basic service tax for sewer at \$325, the service tax for waste management at \$90, the service tax for fire protection at \$105, the minimum tax remain at \$28.00, and the tax for the long term water project at \$260 per unit and that the 18% combined interest rate remain the same.
