By-Law #2022-005 - Remuneration of Elected municipal officials

WHEREAS the Act Respecting the Remuneration of Elected Municipal Officers, (CQLR c T-11.001) outlines the authority of Council in setting their remuneration;

WHEREAS Council has an obligation to adopt a By-law on the remuneration of municipal officials;

WHEREAS the Municipality of L'Isle-aux-Allumettes wishes to compensate their elected officials fairly, in comparison to other officials throughout the MRC Pontiac;

WHEREAS a Notice of Motion and a Draft by-law was given on November 1st, 2022;

CONSEQUENTLY it is proposed by Councillor Adam and seconded by Councillor Sallafranque and resolved that the following ByLaw be adopted:

ARTICLE 1

The preamble is an integral part of this By-law.

ARTICLE 2

This By-law establishes an annual remuneration for the Mayor and each Councillor of the Municipality, for the fiscal year 2023 and all fiscal years thereafter; until the next term of Council.

ARTICLE 3

The annual basic salary and remuneration, for the year 2023, for the Mayor is \$24,000 and for each Councillor is \$8,000.

ARTICLE 4

The remuneration will increase annually, based on the national indexing according to Statistics Canada, as per the annual approval, by way of resolution of Council.



ARTICLE 5

This By-Law shall enter into force according to law the day of its publication.
